

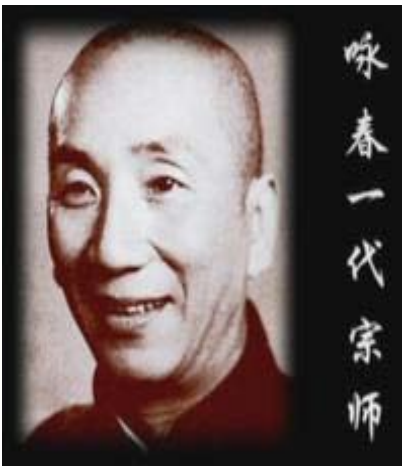

# 叶问



叶问（1893—1972年），本名叶继问，是广东佛山的大族富家子弟。叶问从小受到家庭严谨的儒家教育。从7岁起便拜“咏春拳王”[梁赞](#)的高足[陈华顺](#)（人称华公）为师学习[咏春拳](#)。自收叶问为徒后，陈华顺则不再接受任何人士拜门学技，叶问成为陈华顺封门弟子。华公逝世后，叶问再随师兄吴仲素钻研拳技。叶问十六岁那年，赴港求学外文，就读于圣士提反学校。后随[梁璧](#)（梁赞之子）学武。1950年赴香港，在港九饭店职工总会内传授咏春拳术。其弟子中最出名的是让中国武术闻名世界的武打巨星[李小龙](#)。

Yip Man (1892-December 1, 1972) was born in the town of Sangyuan, Foshan. His family used to live in Lianxing Tantou Village of Luocun County. To avoid the rebellion of "Red Heads", his father moved the whole family to Sangyuan of Foshan. At the age of seven, Yip Man started the training with Chan Wah-shun, who was a well-known student of Wing Chun grandmaster Leung Jan (Liang Zan). In 1950, Yip Man went to Hong Kong and taught martial arts under the help of a close friend. With so many people eager to learn Wing Chun, Yip Man had to move his school again and again for bigger places. At night he would find time to teach in the Hollywood Street and promoted Wing Chun to every corner of Kowloon. Bruce Lee began studying with Yip Man in 1956 in the Kung Fu center of Lee Tat Street. He was very devoted and never missed a single lesson. After becoming famous, Bruce Lee revisited Yip Man and expressed

his hope that he would like to learn the Wooden Dummy skills of Wing Chun. He even proposed that he would offer a building if Yip Man could demonstrate the Wooden Dummy skills personally so that he could shoot the whole process and bring the film back to US for further study. Yip Man, however, refused the request. Some of Yip Man's students thought it was a pity considering the generous offer of Bruce Lee. But Yip Man explained that he would wholeheartedly teach anyone willing to learn, but he would never treat his skills as merchandise for sale. More importantly, he could not favor one student over another. His open mindedness helped to bolster his reputation among his students.
