**Guest Speaker:** Bryan Clontz, CFP is president and co-founder of Charitable Solutions, LLC. For the last decade, he served as the vice president of advancement at The Community Foundation for Greater Atlanta and the national director of planned giving for Boys & Girls Clubs of America. He received a bachelor's of science in business administration from the College of Charleston in Charleston, SC; a master's degree in risk management and insurance from Georgia State University in Atlanta, GA; and a master's degree in financial services from the American College in Bryn Mawr, PA. Bryan was the youngest South Carolinian to ever earn the certified financial planner designation (CFP®), and subsequently earned the chartered life underwriter (CLU), chartered financial consultant (ChFC), accredited estate planner (AEP) and chartered advisor in philanthropy (CAP) designations. For six years, he served as a graduate adjunct professor of personal financial planning and life insurance in the Department of Risk Management and Insurance at Georgia State University. He serves on the Editorial Board of the Planned Giving Design Center, the Advisory Board for the American College's Chartered Advisor in Philanthropy designation, the American Council on Gift Annuities' Rate Recommendation Committee and the National Committee on Planned Giving Board for 2007-2010. He is the proud father of two Chinese daughters (Zoey Bao-Yi, 6, and Olivia Min-Yan, 2) both from Chongqing. His wife, Kim, serves on the Board of First Coast Families with Chinese Children.

On January 15th, a group of Jacksonville parents discussed the idea of establishing a K-2 Chinese Bi-Lingual program in Duval county. Last month, the program was approved by the county and Global Outreach Charter Academy - a public school. The first classes are enrolling now for the 2010 school year.
